



The REIVAC network (French clinical REsearch In VACcinology) was created in 2007, initially composed of four Clinical Investigation Research Centers (CIC). In 2014, in the framework of the F-CRIN call, REIVAC was labelled as the network of excellence for clinical research in vaccinology and became F-CRIN I-REIVAC network.

This network brings together 37 partners: clinicians, biologists and academic researchers with a strong interest in vaccinology research.

The 26 clinical sites are clinical research centers located in hospitals offering to the investigators the necessary resources (nurses, project managers, secretaries...) to assist them in inclusion, data acquisition and data entry, investigation support, interfacing with patients and healthy volunteers for institutional or industrial clinical trials under contract. All these clinical sites work together to achieve the number of inclusion and with local pharmacy and laboratory for the preparation of samples and the extraction of PBMC, if necessary.

Since 2009, 81 studies were conducted within the network, 20 studies are ongoing:

- 41 industrial studies including 4 observational studies,
- 40 academic studies among which 8 European projects, 5 observational and 11 in human and social science studies.
